

# TRAVEL GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT

ASP-DAC 2000 will make a limited number of partial travel grants to worthy conference participants. Assistance is generally limited to part of airfare of the most economical means to and from Tokyo (original receipts to be submitted later). Conference registration fee is not covered by the grant this year. Also note that the number of grants is subject to the conference budget and can be very limited this year. Priority will be given to technical paper presenters, design contest participants, and panelists belonging to academic institutions. Within those groups, priority will be given to individuals belonging to institutions which offer matching support.

## Request Procedures

In a letter of request for a travel grant, please provide:

- your name,
- name of affiliated institution and your position at the institution,
- complete mail and e-mail addresses and phone and fax numbers,
- the name, mail and e-mail addresses, and phone and fax numbers of your faculty advisor or technical manager,
- your conference participation role (including session number if you will be presenting an accepted paper), schedule for that participation, and overall dates of conference attendance, and
- expected expenses and expected institutional support (if any).

Please explain the rationale for your request. Merely having had your paper accepted is not sufficient. Supporting arguments from your faculty advisor or technical manager are strongly encouraged. Also, if your institution is supporting travel grant requests for more than one participant, any supporting arguments should be bundled and must address the total quantity of requested grants as well as the merit of each individual request.
