ASP-DAC 2025 Sustainability Report

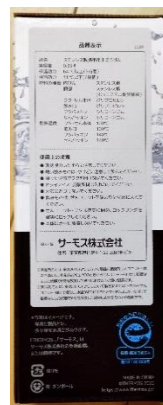


ASP-DAC 2025 took various sustainability actions to minimize the conference's negative environmental and social impacts.

Plastic Bottle Reduction



- ASP-DAC 2025 provided a water bottle with “Eco Mark” labeled with the 30th-anniversary logo to each attendee as a give-away, which is supported by Tokyo Convention & Visitors Bureau. Eco Mark is the certificate of low environmental impact throughout its life cycle from production to disposal, reviewed by the Japan Environment Association.
- Water filling stations are installed in the poster / exhibition room and the lobby of the venue.

- ASP-DAC 2025 contributed to minimizing the number of printings during the conference. Final program and Proceedings are distributed online.

Paper Badges

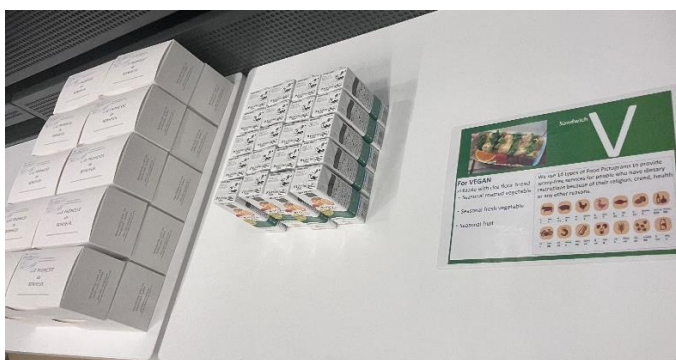
- ASP-DAC 2025 used paper badges to eliminate the plastic from the conference badge holder.
